An Act relating to cigarette and tobacco dealers licenses; amending 68 O.S. 2011, Section 341, which relates to cancellation of license for certain violation; adding causes for cancellation of certain license; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Cigarette and tobacco


BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 2011, Section 341, is amended to read as follows:

Section 341. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall cancel the license of any cigarette or tobacco dealer who has been determined by any court to have violated the provisions of ~~this act~~ the Unfair Cigarette and Tobacco Product Sales Act, or has been convicted for violation of any law pertaining to the use, possession, manufacture or sale of any controlled substance pursuant to the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act, or has been found guilty of a violation of any rule promulgated or order issued to control a new product or noncontrolled product or substance pursuant to Section 2-201 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, or convicted of a violation of any drug or narcotic law of the United States.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
