RESOLUTION NO. 1002

A Resolution relating to the House Rules; establishing a Special Rule for House Bills 1002, 1003, 1004, 1005, 1006, 1007, 1008, 1009, 1010, 1011, 1012, 1013, 1014 and 1015 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature; providing that the Special Rule shall take precedence when in conflict with the House Rules; providing for strict construction of the Special Rule; and providing for termination of the Special Rule.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. A Special Rule is created herein pursuant to Section 7.26 of House Rules adopted for the 54th Oklahoma Legislature.

SECTION 2. The following provisions shall apply during consideration of House Bills 1002, 1003, 1004, 1005, 1006, 1007, 1008, 1009, 1010, 1011, 1012, 1013, 1014 and 1015 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature:

Questions and Answers: No more than one hundred eighty (180) minutes of total time shall be expended on questions and answers related to all measures listed in this Special Rule.

Floor Amendments: No Floor amendment shall be presented to or considered by the House on the measures listed in this Special Rule.

Points of Order or Inquiry: No more than ten (10) points of order or inquiry may be raised by a member of each political party.

SECTION 3. The terms of this Special Rule shall take precedence when in conflict with the House Rules; otherwise, the House Rules shall remain applicable. The presiding officer shall strictly construe the provisions of this Special Rule.

SECTION 4. The terms of this Special Rule shall become effective upon Thursday, September 5, 2013, and this Special Rule shall terminate upon completion of consideration of the measures named herein.
