An Act relating to professions and occupations;  
requiring the Oklahoma Board of Nursing to develop  
guidelines for certain nursing education programs;  
providing for codification; and providing an  
effective date.

SUBJECT: Nursing education programs

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 567.20 of Title 59, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:


On or before December 31, 2015, the Oklahoma Board of Nursing  
shall develop program guidelines for Board-approved nursing  
education programs to utilize in transitioning veterans with prior  
military medical training and experience into nursing education  
programs. The process of transition shall include the provisions of  
Section 4100.3 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.


