ENROLLED HOUSE BILL NO. 3176:

This is to advise you that on this date, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Section 11 of Article VI of the Oklahoma Constitution to approve or object to legislation presented to me, I have VETOED House Bill 3176.

House Bill 3176 would change the amount of paid time that a State employee can use to attend job-related meetings held by professional organizations of which he or she is a member, from three days to twenty-four hours. This change would allow state employees to have increased participation in professional and trade organizations at the tax payers' expense. House Bill 3176 is not in the interest of the citizens of Oklahoma.
