ENROLLED HOUSE BILL NO. 3359:

This is to advise you that on this date, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Section 11 of Article VI of the Oklahoma Constitution to approve or object to legislation presented to me, I have VETOED House Bill 3359

House Bill 3359 creates the Oklahoma Construction Registry Act and creates a nine-member advisory council to assist and advise the administrator in the development, design, implementation and operation of the Construction Registry (Registry). The administrator of the Registry would be the Secretary of State.

While I support the modernization of the construction lien registration process, I do not support the expansion of government. This Bill expands government through the creation of the advisory council. Therefore, I have vetoed House Bill 3359.
