A Resolution designating the month of March as TBI Raiders Month; providing that information concerning TBI Raiders Month can be found on certain website.

WHEREAS, the State of Oklahoma is in the top ten states each year with the most cases of traumatic brain injury (TBI); and

WHEREAS, in 2010, 4,221 Oklahomans sustained a TBI; and

WHEREAS, suicide is the highest cause of death from a TBI; and

WHEREAS, many students with a TBI feel like "they stick out like a sore thumb"; and

WHEREAS, while in 1999 motor vehicle accidents were listed as the leading cause of TBI, in 2010 the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention had "falls" listed as the leading cause of TBI.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the month of March is hereby designated in the State of Oklahoma as TBI Raiders Month.
