A Resolution stating legislative intent regarding proposed permanent rule of the Oklahoma Health Care Authority; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 250.2 and 308 of Title 75 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Legislature reserves the right to designate the method for rule promulgation, establish policy, determine that a rule is not consistent with legislative intent and disapprove any rule or portion thereof at any time; and

WHEREAS, on March 27, 2014, the Oklahoma Health Care Authority submitted to the Legislature for its review a proposed amendment to OAC 317:30-5-241.3(b)(3), which relates to qualified providers; and

WHEREAS, proposed permanent rule OAC 317:30-5-241.3(b)(3) does not reflect the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma Health Care Authority amend the last two sentences of 317:30-5-241.3(b)(3), which relates to qualified providers to read as follows:

"A minimum of one monthly face-to-face consultation with a fully licensed LBHP is required. A minimum of one face-to-face consultation per week with a LBHP is required for PSR providers."

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority.
