An Act relating to appropriations to the Ethics Commission; modifying effective date of certain provisions; and declaring an emergency.

SUBJECT: Ethics Commission

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. The provisions of Section 135 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 2127 of the 2nd Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature shall become effective July 1, 2014.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
