An Act relating to county records; amending 19 O.S. 2011, Section 517.1, which relates to maintenance and disposal of departmental records; modifying requirement for keeping certain records; deleting certain requirement for disposal of such records; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Maintenance of county records

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 517.1, is amended to read as follows:

Section 517.1 The governing body of each county may establish a length of time for the county to keep departmental records and authorize the sheriff to properly dispose of or convert to microfilm or a similar medium all records not specifically addressed in other statutes. Such records shall be kept for a minimum of seven (7) years; provided, however, if the sheriff is the sole source for such records, the records shall ~~not be destroyed but shall be kept in retrievable form~~ be kept for a minimum of seven (7) years.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
