An Act relating to higher education; directing the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education to adopt a policy granting resident tuition eligibility to certain students at certain institutions of higher education; providing criteria for ineligibility; providing for promulgation of rules; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

SUBJECT: Eligibility for resident tuition

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3242.3 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education shall adopt a policy which allows a student to enroll in an institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education and be eligible for resident tuition if the student:

1. Satisfies admission standards as determined by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education for the appropriate type of institution and has secured admission to and enrolled in an institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education; and

2. Presents to the institution valid documentation of receipt of an Air Force Reserve Officers' Training Corps, Army Reserve Officers' Training Corps or Navy/Marines Reserve Officers' Training Corps full scholarship.

B. Students who are only participants in or who have received only partial scholarships from the Air Force Reserve Officers' Training Corps, Army Reserve Officers' Training Corps or the Navy/Marines Reserve Officers' Training Corps shall not be eligible for resident tuition as provided for in subsection A.

C. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2014.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
