WHEREAS, the Guthrie High School football team won their fourth Class 5A Football State Championship on Saturday, December 14, 2013, at Oklahoma State University's Boone Pickens Stadium; and

WHEREAS, with a 30-point margin of victory, Guthrie's win has been marked as the largest Class 5A State Championship victory margin since 1997; and

WHEREAS, senior running back Kai Callins secured the team's win with a career high of 234 yards and four touchdowns; and

WHEREAS, the victory was the BlueJays' second state championship in three years.


