An Act relating to cities and towns; prohibiting municipalities from adopting certain ordinances; providing exception; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Municipal ordinances

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 13-116 of Title 11, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

No municipality shall adopt an ordinance restricting or expanding the powers and duties, supervisory and management authority, or the regulation of day-to-day activities of a duly elected law enforcement officer unless such authority is specifically granted by the municipal charter of said municipality.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.


