An Act relating to crimes and punishments; repealing 21 O.S. 2011, Sections 1844, 1845, 1846 and 1847, which relate to emergency telephone calls on party lines; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Emergency telephone calls on party lines

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. REPEALER 21 O.S. 2011, Sections 1844, 1845, 1846 and 1847, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
