An Act relating to the Governor; requiring official acts of the Governor to be recorded by Secretary of State; making records available to public; repealing 74 O.S. 2011, Section 3, which relates to the Governor's official journal; repealing 74 O.S. 2011, Section 5, which relates to Governor's reward for criminal's arrest; and repealing 74 O.S. 2011, Section 9.11, which relates to Division of Planning and Management Analysis within the Governor's Office.

SUBJECT: Governor operating procedures

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3.1 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Official acts of the Governor shall be recorded and maintained by the Secretary of State. Such official records shall be available to the public as provided by law.

SECTION 2. REPEALER 74 O.S. 2011, Section 3, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. REPEALER 74 O.S. 2011, Section 5, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. REPEALER 74 O.S. 2011, Section 9.11, is hereby repealed.
