WHEREAS, the Wagoner Bulldogs football program has had much success on the field in recent years winning the 2011 and 2014 Class 4A Championships; and

WHEREAS, the defending champions secured back-to-back titles after defeating the Oologah Mustangs in the final seconds of the 2015 Class 4A State Championship at Owasso Stadium; and

WHEREAS, the Wagoner football team saw an even greater victory as two of their teammates, sophomores Marshall McKinney and Austin Condict, beat cancer during the season.


