A Resolution expressing gratitude to Senator Patrick Anderson for his service in the Oklahoma State Senate; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Senator Patrick Anderson is completing his twelfth year of service to the citizens of District 19 in the Oklahoma State Senate; and

WHEREAS, Patrick Anderson was born and raised in Enid, Oklahoma. After graduating from Oklahoma State University, Senator Anderson received his Juris Doctorate from the University of Oklahoma School of Law. Senator Anderson is employed as a Vice President at Central National Bank & Trust Company of Enid and also farms in Garfield County. He and his wife Kelly still reside in Enid with their two daughters; and

WHEREAS, Patrick Anderson was a member of the first post-term-limits class of 2004, and has been a member of the Oklahoma State Senate since that time, serving first in the minority, then in the evenly-divided Senate and finally in the majority. Senator Anderson serves as Vice-chair of the Veterans and Military Affairs Committee; and

WHEREAS, State Question 632, adopted September 18, 1990, and effective January 1, 1991, limits the length of service for a member of the Legislature to a total of twelve years and as a result, Senator Anderson will not be eligible to stand for reelection this year; and

WHEREAS, Patrick Anderson was never one to shy away from blazing his own path. He also found ways to infuse his dry sense of humor along the way. The balancing of tough issues while maintaining an even keel speaks to his keen sense of perspective. It is that perspective that has contributed to his overall successes in life and has served him well in the Senate.
