A Resolution expressing gratitude to Senator Ron Justice for his service in the Oklahoma State Senate; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Senator Ron Justice is completing his twelfth year of service to the citizens of District 23 in the Oklahoma State Senate; and

WHEREAS, Senator Justice received both his Bachelor of Science Degree and his Masters Degree from Oklahoma State University. Senator Justice is a retired Oklahoma State University County Extension Agent. He and his wife Darlene have one son, Greg, and two daughters, Yvonne and Yvette; and

WHEREAS, Ron Justice was a member of the first post-term-limits class of 2004, and has been a member of the Oklahoma State Senate

since that time, serving first in the minority, then in the evenly-divided Senate and finally in the majority. Senator Justice serves as Chair of the Appropriations Subcommittee on Natural Resources and Regulatory Services and Vice-chair of Agriculture and Rural Development; and

WHEREAS, State Question No. 632, adopted September 18, 1990, and effective January 1, 1991, limits the length of service for a member of the Legislature to a total of twelve years and as a result, Senator Justice will not be eligible to stand for reelection this year; and

WHEREAS, Ron Justice will always be known for his perpetual optimism. With a warm smile and calming presence, Senator Justice quickly emerged as a leader among his peers. However, it was not just his genuine kindness that inspired others, he proved to be a man of trust throughout his tenure with the Senate. He used those gifts for his passion of rural issues and all the while made lasting relationships with the people around him.
