A Resolution commending Clyde McMasters and Don McMasters for their extraordinary service to our country; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, twin brothers Clyde McMasters and Don McMasters both enlisted in the Navy in Oklahoma City in 1942; and

WHEREAS, Clyde and Don McMasters received their private pilot licenses and Navy Wings during training; and

WHEREAS, Clyde and Don McMasters were assigned to the same squadron during World War II, during which they successfully completed anti-submarine patrols and air-sea rescues; and

WHEREAS, when the war ended both brothers obtained master's degrees in business and entered the insurance business with their father; and

WHEREAS, the brothers still desired to serve their country and joined the Naval Training Unit in Tulsa and, thereafter, the Naval Air Station in Dallas; and

WHEREAS, both Clyde and Don McMasters achieved the rank of Captain in April 1967, and retired from active duty in 1969.
