An Act relating to initiative and referendum;
authorizing certain registered voters to use certain
address to sign initiative and referendum petitions;
providing for codification; and providing an
effective date.

SUBJECT: Initiative and referendum

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3.2 of Title 34, unless there is
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Registered voters signing an initiative or referendum petition
who are certified by the Office of the Attorney General as
participants in the Address Confidentiality Program established by
Section 60.14 of Title 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes may use the
address given to the registered voter by the Office of the Attorney
General to sign an initiative or referendum petition.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
