SUBJECT: Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department


BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Oklahoma Tourism Capital Improvement Revolving Fund (267 Fund) the sum of Five Hundred Eight Thousand Thirty-one Dollars (\$508,031.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to implement the provisions of Enrolled House Bill No. 2753 of the 2nd Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature.




