WHEREAS, National Nurses Week is a time of year to reflect on the important contributions that nurses make to provide safe, high-quality health care; and

WHEREAS, nurses represent a large segment of the health care workforce, with an estimated population of 4 million registered nurses in the United States; and

WHEREAS, nurses walk on average 4 to 5 miles during a 12-hour shift; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that 438,100 new nursing jobs will be created by 2026; and


