

## Proclamation

*Whereas, it is most appropriate that we honor all American patriots who made the supreme sacrifice in service to our country; and*

*Whereas, while we honor their memory on Memorial Day, this country has never had an officially recognized symbol, solely dedicated to the American men and women who bravely made the ultimate sacrifice to preserve the freedoms we enjoy; and*

*Whereas, the Honor and Remember Flag recognizes those individuals from all wars or conflicts involving the United States who died, not only those killed in action, but all who have died in the line of duty; and*

*Whereas, the State Legislature has recognized the Honor and Remember Flag as a way for the citizens of Oklahoma to acknowledge and remember the ultimate price of freedom given by the American men and women who have lost their lives while serving and protecting our country;*

*Now, therefore, I, Brad Henry, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby recognize November 11, 2010, as*

### **“Honor and Remember Day”**

*in the State of Oklahoma, and encourage all Oklahomans to honor and cherish the memory of all men and women who have died in service to our great Nation, remembering forever their sacrifices on behalf of the freedoms and ideals America was built upon.*
