

*Whereas, student leaders are a positive influence on their peers, modeling good character and scholarship in and out of the classroom, and serve as change agents to improve the overall climate and academic performance levels of their schools; and*

*Whereas, student leaders do not automatically develop sound leadership skills and require trained, dedicated faculty advisers to help young people develop the essential traits and characteristics of a leader and to provide the positive experiences necessary to expand their skills and foster their paths to becoming effective leaders; and*

*Whereas, the support of school administrators and faculty, parents, and community members is necessary to help ensure the successful education of emerging student leaders; and*

*Whereas, the Oklahoma Association of Student Councils serves as an ideal opportunity to bring attention to the important and integral contributions that student leaders and leadership training makes in our nations' schools; and*

*Whereas, the 70<sup>th</sup> Annual Convention of the Oklahoma Association of Student Councils will be held November 6 – 8, 2010;*

*Now, therefore, I, Brad Henry, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim November 6 – 8, 2010, as*

### **“Oklahoma Association of Student Councils Days”**

*in the State of Oklahoma, and urge citizens to seek opportunities to recognize student leaders in our schools and support their training and activities.*
