

# Proclamation

Whereas, Chesapeake Energy Corporation has formed many partnerships with beautification and environmental organizations in Oklahoma including The Tree Bank Foundation; and

Whereas, Chesapeake Energy Corporation strives to be good stewards of Oklahoma's natural resources and to leave the Oklahoma environment a better place through tree planting, practical application of environmentally-sound principles of land use, planning, and other activities that will improve the quality of life, particularly in areas in which Chesapeake Energy Corporation operates; and

Whereas, the Chesapeake Energy Corporation Tree Program purchased and donated young trees, three gallon size, for beautification projects at Oklahoma community non-profits, schools, cities, universities, athletic associations, youth associations, and others; and

Whereas, Chesapeake Energy Corporation Tree Program donated more than 1,900 trees to Oklahoma's landscape to assist in recovery of the storm damaged urban forest; and

Whereas, Chesapeake Energy Corporation's commitment to urban forestry has been demonstrated by its support of The Tree Bank Foundation, a statewide urban forestry project for public lands. Through Chesapeake Energy Corporation's financial support, trees and shrubs have been provided at wholesale and discounted prices for distribution to Oklahoma's public and non profit organization property to improve the health and beauty of our communities;

Now, therefore, I, Brad Henry, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim December 1, 2010, as

### "Chesapeake Energy Tree Program Day"

in the State of Oklahoma.
