

Proclamation

Whereas, the Main Street program is a nationally recognized model for revitalizing historic downtowns and neighborhood business districts; and

Whereas, the Oklahoma Main Street Center has successfully guided the Main Street program since 1986 using the proven national model for downtown revitalization – the Four Point Approach: Organization, Promotion, Design, and Economic Restructuring; and

Whereas, the Oklahoma Main Street Center oversees 41 Oklahoma communities including five urban districts actively participating in the Oklahoma Main Street Program; and

Whereas, over \$774 billion have been invested in the Oklahoma Main Street Program, more than 13,300 new jobs have been created and more than 4,200 businesses have started or expanded throughout the state;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim May 2, 2011 as

"Oklahoma Main Street Day"

in the state of Oklahoma.
