

Proclamation

Whereas, these unsung heroes do the work that keeps our nation moving; and

Whereas, many public servants, including military personnel, police officers, firefighters, health care professionals and countless others risk their lives each day in service to the people of Oklahoma and the United States; and

Whereas, public servants include teachers, doctors and scientists, as well as train conductors and astronauts, nurses and safety inspectors, computer technicians and social workers, and countless other occupations; and

Whereas, day in and day out they provide the diverse services demanded by our state government and do so with integrity; and

Whereas, without these public servants at every level, continuity would be impossible in a democracy that regularly changes its leaders and elected officials;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim May 1st through May 7th, 2011 as

"Public Service Recognition Week"

in the state of Oklahoma.
