

Proclamation

Whereas, Job Corps is being recognized for its 30 years of continued excellence while fulfilling the Department of Labor's vision with initiatives to assist youth in achieving a positive outcome with the aide of center staff; and

Whereas, the mission of Job Corps is to provide eligible young adults an opportunity to learn the necessary skills needed to become employable, independent and place them in meaningful jobs or further their education; and

Whereas, Job Corps is a nationally recognized Career Development Center for at-risk, out-of-school young adults; and

Whereas, Job Corps is preparing young people for the workplace through school-to-work, principles of applied academics, contextual learning and connecting with employers through partnership; and

Whereas, Job Corps is certified to issue high school diplomas to eligible students; and

Whereas, the students (16 to 24 years-of-age) and staff constitute a population that are putting back into the communities through training, community service, and jobs for the State of Oklahoma;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim May 17, 2011 as

"Job Corps Day"

in the State of Oklahoma.
