

Whereas, Spay Day is officially the last Tuesday of February throughout the United States and globally; and

Whereas, Spay Day USA was established 17 years ago by the Doris Day Animal Foundation to spotlight spay/neuter as the simple, humane solution to the tragedy of pet overpopulation; and

Whereas, on Spay Day and throughout the month of February, the HSUS brings together hundreds of spay/neuter events to create a wave of spay/neuter activity and awareness across the country; and

Whereas, Spay Day calls upon all the citizens of our great state to help spread this important message across our communities as the means to end the suffering of innocent animals. By doing so, we can save many animal's lives;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim February 28, 2012 as

"Oklahoma Spay Day"
