

Proclamation

Whereas, the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation was established in 1955 to assure the development of the means to cure and control cystic fibrosis and to improve the quality of life for those with the disease; and

Whereas, cystic fibrosis is a life-threatening genetic disease that affects the lungs and digestive system; and

Whereas, just 50 years ago, children with cystic fibrosis usually did not live long enough to attend elementary school and today, they are living to a median age of 37; and

Whereas, the "Tulsa's New Leaders" event, benefiting the Sooner-Tulsa Chapter of the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation, will honor the most outstanding Tulsa men and women who have exemplified leadership by their charitable and civic contributions to the Metro Tulsa's business community on April 5, 2012, at the Hyatt Regency;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim April 5, 2012 as

"Tulsa's New Leaders Day"

in the State of Oklahoma.
