

Proclamation

Whereas, there are more than 44,000 children across Oklahoma that are affected by a disability; and

Whereas, children with disabilities are often misunderstood, bullied or related to in the wrong capacity due to a lack of understanding; and

Whereas, peer groups need to be informed of the core values of awareness, acceptance and assistance for those with disabilities; and

Whereas, proper education and awareness of children with disabilities can empower peer groups to help, build awareness and teach tolerance; and

Whereas, Children with Disabilities Awareness Month celebrated in March of 2013 will give proper education regarding children with disabilities, empower peer groups to assist, increase knowledge and understanding, and teach tolerance; and

Whereas, the Muscular Dystrophy Association was founded in 1950 as a support agency for families of people diagnosed with neuromuscular disease;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim the month of March 2013 as

“Children with Disabilities Awareness Month”

in the State of Oklahoma.
