

Proclamation

Whereas, the Oklahoma Farm Bureau as a nonprofit general farm organization in all 77 counties within boundaries of the state of Oklahoma, has served the farmers and ranchers of this great state since 1942; and

Whereas, the Oklahoma Farm Bureau, through its concern for both producers and consumers, helps to develop a basic understanding of the complex structure that puts food on the tables of all Americans and most of the world; and

Whereas, the Oklahoma Farm Bureau has dedicated itself and its members to maintain agriculture as an honorable and respected profession, which has been the base for much of the economic prosperity in the state of Oklahoma; and

Whereas, more than 100,000 families in Oklahoma are members of the Oklahoma Farm Bureau, the state's largest general farm organization;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim the week of February 18th through February 22nd, 2013 as

"Farm Bureau Week"

in the State of Oklahoma.
