

Proclamation

Whereas, High School Bowling is sweeping the nation; and

Whereas, Oklahoma is the 28th state to develop a High School Bowling Program, with over 100 schools participating and servicing more than 2,000 students; and

Whereas, Oklahoma High School Bowling has grown to include 30 participating bowling centers statewide; and

Whereas, Oklahoma High School Bowling is self sufficient, leaving the schools involved and the high school bowlers, themselves, with no cost to participate in the program; and

Whereas, Oklahoma High School Bowling is dedicated to being the premier after school bowling program for youths, providing opportunities to the students across the great state of Oklahoma; and

Whereas, the Oklahoma High School Bowling State Championship is held on February 23, 2013, at Andy B's Family Entertainment Center in Tulsa, Oklahoma;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim February 23, 2013 as

"Oklahoma High School Bowling Day"

in the State of Oklahoma.
