

Whereas, Beta Sigma Phi Sorority, the world's largest international Greek letter organization, with more than 200,000 members from over 12,500 chapters in 31 countries, was founded on April 30, 1931; and

Whereas, the Beta Sigma Phi International Endowment Fund promotes the additional aim of "service free from self and selfishness" through the support of such projects as working with exceptional children, as well as rehabilitation centers for pre-delinquent boys and girls; and

Whereas, Beta Sigma Phi's social, cultural and service programs have a significant impact on the lives of its members, as well as their communities and local, state and national government officials around the world;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim April 22<sup>nd</sup> through April 26<sup>th</sup>, 2013 as
