

Proclamation

Whereas, American citizens are served every day by public servants at the federal, state, county and city levels; and

Whereas, public employees take not only jobs, but oaths; and

Whereas, many public servants, including military personnel, law enforcement officers, firefighters, border patrol officers, embassy personnel, health care professionals, corrections employees, and others, risk their lives daily in service to the people of the United States and around the world; and

Whereas, public servants include educators, doctors and scientists, train conductors, air traffic controllers, nurses and safety inspectors, laborers, information technology professionals, social workers, and numerous other occupations. Day in and day out, they strive to provide vital and diverse services, required by the American people, with efficiency and integrity; and

Whereas, without these public servants at every level, continuity would be impossible in a democracy that regularly transitions its leaders and elected officials; and

Whereas, Public Service Recognition Week, celebrated the first Monday through Sunday in May since 1985, is a time set aside to honor the men and women who devote their careers to public service;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim May 5th through May 11th, 2013 as

"Public Service Recognition Week"

in the State of Oklahoma.
