Proclamation

Whereas, Job Corps' mission is to provide eligible young adults an opportunity to learn the skills needed to become employable and independent and place them in meaningful jobs or further their education; and

Whereas, Job Corps is a nationally recognized career development center for at-risk out-of-school young adults (ages 16 to 24 years old); and

Whereas, Job Corps is preparing young people for the workplace through school-to-work principles of applied academics, contextual learning and by connecting with employers through partnerships; and

Whereas, Job Corps in Oklahoma is certified to issue high school diplomas to eligible students; and

Whereas, the students and staff constitute a population of over 4,000 who are putting back to the state of Oklahoma through training, community service, and hard work;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim May 13, 2013 as

"Job Corps Legislative Day"

in the State of Oklahoma.
