Whereas, the state of Oklahoma recognizes that important mortgage information should not be buried in the fine print and prospective homeowners must have a better understanding of the home buying process, thereby providing them the means to make well-informed financial decisions; and

Whereas, the state of Oklahoma recognizes the local, state, federal, private and nonprofit housing professionals are dedicated to helping Oklahomans achieve and retain their dream of homeownership;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim June 2013 as

"Homeownership Month"

in the state of Oklahoma.
