

## Proclamation

Whereas, *She's Somebody's Daughter Day* is designed to bring dignity to all women and children; and

Whereas, the truth needs to be spoken about pornography and its connections to the breakdown of families, marriages and sexual exploitation; and

Whereas, raising awareness about the realities of pornography, along with its role in driving the demand for sex-trafficking and violence against women and children is fundamental in empowering people to act; and

Whereas, *She's Somebody's Daughter* is a movement to start a national conversation speaking the truth about pornography and encouraging our culture to honor women and children;

Now, therefore, I, *Mary Fallin*, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2013 as

### "*She's Somebody's Daughter Day*"

in the state of Oklahoma and urge that this day be observed by taking time to recognize and acknowledge the dignity of every woman and child, beginning with those in our own lives.
