

Proclamation

Whereas, the National Association of REALTORS® was founded in 1908 in Chicago, Illinois for the express purpose of protecting buyers and sellers of real property through establishment and enforcement of ethical and professional standards for real estate brokers; and

Whereas, the founders' dream was realized in 1913 in Winnipeg, Manitoba with the adoption of the Association's Code of Ethics; and

Whereas, for a century, the Code of Ethics has called upon REALTORS® to ensure "... the creation of adequate housing, the building of functioning cities, the development of productive industries and farms, and the preservation of a healthful environment..."; and

Whereas, the Code of Ethics is a living, dynamic document continuously reviewed and enhanced in light of changing consumer needs, emerging technologies and evolving industry practices to remain meaningful and relevant; and

Whereas, the Code of Ethics is the manifestation of REALTORS®' promises of professionalism and performance; and

Whereas, vigorous enforcement of the Code of Ethics affords REALTORS®' clients a clear, concise and compelling assurance their interests will be placed ahead of REALTORS®' personal interests; and

Whereas, the 8,300 REALTOR® members of the Oklahoma Association of REALTORS® recognizes this Code of Ethics and voluntarily commit to guide their professional lives by the Code's duties and obligations;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim September 26, 2013 as

"REALTORS® Code of Ethics Centennial Celebration Day"

in the state of Oklahoma.
