

Proclamation

Whereas, the health and well-being of our citizens is of primary concern for the state of Oklahoma; and

Whereas, promoting safer, healthier diets is a critical factor in improving the overall health of Oklahomans; and

Whereas, supporting sustainable family farms and local agriculture benefits the state's economy; and

Whereas, fair pay and safe conditions for food and farm workers are beneficial for both the producer and consumer to help ensure the food we produce and consume is safe and fair for all; and

Whereas, expanding access to food and reducing hunger is of critical importance to aid those who live in food deserts;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim October 24th, 2013 as

"Food Day"

in the state of Oklahoma.
