

## Proclamation

*Whereas, the state of Oklahoma has administered the Weatherization Assistance Program since its inception in 1976, providing jobs and funding to local communities by operating through a network of well-trained community action agencies that serve all 77 counties in Oklahoma; and*

*Whereas, the state of Oklahoma has a long standing commitment to conserve its resources and help low-income households through its Weatherization Assistance Program; and*

*Whereas, the state of Oklahoma recognizes the significance of those programs that ensure all residents, especially those most vulnerable living at or below the federal poverty level, have the opportunity to live in energy efficient, healthy, safe and comfortable homes as provided by the Weatherization Assistance Program; and*

*Whereas, October is National Energy Awareness Month, and October 30<sup>th</sup> is designated as National Weatherization Day;*

*Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim October 30, 2013 as*

***“Weatherization Day”***

*in the state of Oklahoma.*
