

Proclamation

Whereas, Birth Choice Oklahoma, Inc. is a service agency, existing solely to assist pregnant women; and

Whereas, Birth Choice exists to provide any pregnant woman whatever practical assistance necessary so that she may choose the gift of life for her unborn baby; and

Whereas, Birth Choice responds to the needs of pregnant women, to enhance their ability to become self-sufficient and sustain a lifestyle which will facilitate a positive contribution to society; and

Whereas, Birth Choice exists to provide any pregnant woman and her friends and family, compassionate dialog, one-on-one help, and nurturing support; and

Whereas, Birth Choice provides each woman every practical assistance necessary to help her appreciate her worth and that of her unborn child; and

Whereas, Birth Choice provides free pregnancy testing, maternity and infant clothing, crisis counseling, community referrals, transportation for medical and other care, and housing. They also operate Rose Home for homeless pregnant women; and

Whereas, since its founding in 1973, Birth Choice has conservatively helped over 300,000 women in Oklahoma City, the surrounding areas, and other towns throughout the state of Oklahoma;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim October 6th, 2013 as

"Birth Choice Day"

in the state of Oklahoma.
