

Whereas, sudden cardiac arrest does not discriminate against age, race or gender; and

Whereas, the Sudden Cardiac Arrest Association – Tulsa Chapter, is a nonprofit, volunteer organization that advocates for the public awareness of sudden cardiac arrest; and

Whereas, early Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and the proper use of automated external defibrillators (AED), aid in the prevention of tragic SCA deaths; and

Whereas, the Sudden Cardiac Arrest Association – Tulsa Chapter, provides support for family members and friends of those affected by SCA;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim October 2013 as
