

Proclamation

Whereas, in 2013, the Oklahoma Municipal League celebrated 100 years of honorable service to cities and towns of Oklahoma; and

Whereas, in 1913, leaders from the five founding Oklahoma communities met in Ada to form an organization dedicated to giving a voice to both small and large municipalities across Oklahoma; and

Whereas, the visionary founders of the Oklahoma Municipal League set out to establish an organization dedicated to building the Oklahoma economy through municipal research, training, and advocacy; and

Whereas, the city leaders and staff of the Oklahoma Municipal League have cooperatively strived to promote excellence in municipal government and meet the need of the citizens; and

Whereas, the mission of the Oklahoma Municipal League is to provide services and programs to assist municipal officials to better serve their citizens, and to act as the representative of Oklahoma municipalities in interactions requiring a united voice;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim January 29, 2014 as

“Oklahoma Municipal League Day”

in the state of Oklahoma.
