Whereas, the Smokin' Red Dirt Cook-off will be an annual event in Enid, Oklahoma; and

Whereas, the Smokin' Red Dirt Cook-off is open to all and dedicated to furthering the art of hardwood smoking through public education; and

Whereas, the Smokin' Red Dirt Cook-off is a sanctioned event of the Kansas City Barbecue Society (KCBS), and as such will draw contestants from all over the state of Oklahoma, as well as several other states, to participate in the event; and

Whereas, the greatest recognition a barbecue cook can obtain is the opportunity to cook in the American Royal Invitational Cook-off, which is open to all winners of KCBS sanctioned barbecue contests; and

Whereas, the Grand Champion of the Smokin' Red Dirt Cook-off will receive an invitation to the American Royal Barbecue Cook-off;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim April 12, 2014 as

"Smokin' Red Dirt Barbecue Cook-off Day"
