Proclamation

Whereas, public works infrastructure, facilities, and services are of vital importance to sustainable communities and to the health, safety, and well-being of the people of Oklahoma; and

Whereas, communities rely on the dedicated efforts of public works professionals, engineers, and employees from state and local units of government, who are responsible for and must plan, design, build, operate, and maintain the transportation, water, sewer and refuse disposal, public buildings, and other structures and facilities essential to serve Oklahomans; and

Whereas, it is beneficial for the citizens, and civic leaders of Oklahoma and the United States to learn about and maintain an interest in the public works and public works programs in their communities; and

Whereas, the year 2014 marks the 50th anniversary of the founding of the Oklahoma Chapter of the American Public Works Association;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim May 18th through May 24th, 2014 as

"Public Works Week"

in the state of Oklahoma.
