

Proclamation

Whereas, September 17, 2014, marks the two hundred twenty-seventh anniversary of the signing of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and

Whereas, the Constitution of the United States of America, is the framework of our system of government, and guardian of our liberties; it embodies the principles of limited government in a Republic dedicated to rule by law; and

Whereas, it is fitting and proper to officially recognize this magnificent document and the anniversary of its creation; and

Whereas, Congress, by Joint Resolution, requested the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America designating September 17th through September 23rd, as "Constitution Week";

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim September 17th through September 23rd, 2014 as

"Constitution Week"

in the state of Oklahoma.

In Witness Whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Oklahoma to be affixed.



Done at the Capitol, in the City of Oklahoma City, this 21st day of August, in the Year of Our Lord two thousand and fourteen, and of the State of Oklahoma in the one hundred and sixth year.
