Whereas, for sixty-six years, school child nutrition programs have contributed to the needs of Oklahoma's students, providing quality food at the lowest possible cost; and

Whereas, adequate nutrition is vital to health and enhance our children's ability to learn; and

Whereas, the citizens of Oklahoma are urged to increase awareness and understanding regarding the benefits of nutritious school lunches; and

Whereas, there is a cooperative effort, involving the United States Department of Agriculture and our state, to ensure that school meals are reflective of current scientific studies promote good lifetime eating habits; and

Whereas, Oklahoma schools offer meals that incorporate both the Dietary Guidelines for Americans and MyPlate nutrition guidelines;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim October 13th through October 19th, 2014 as

"Oklahoma School Lunch Week"

in the state of Oklahoma.
