

Proclamation

Whereas, through this dedication, commitment, and investment of intellect, members of the allied health professions make a vital contribution to the quality and excellence of healthcare service delivery, education, and health science research;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim the week of November 2nd through November 8th, 2014 as

in the state of Oklahoma.
