

Proclamation

Whereas, the state of Oklahoma stands committed to protecting human rights and individual freedom by eliminating human trafficking; and

Whereas, to successfully combat human trafficking, the people of Oklahoma must be informed about the problem in its local context, work to protect victims of human trafficking with effective services and support, prosecute traffickers, provide public awareness, and address the root causes of modern slavery; and

Whereas, fighting human trafficking is a shared responsibility. During the month of January, I urge all Oklahomans to educate themselves about all forms of human trafficking and the signs and consequences thereof. Together, we can end this terrible violation and protect the rights of life, liberty, and justice entrusted to us by our forebears and owed to our children;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim January 2015 as

“Oklahoma Human Trafficking Awareness and Prevention Month”

in the state of Oklahoma.
