

Proclamation

Whereas, the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation, a nonprofit donor-supported organization, was established in 1955 to cure and control cystic fibrosis and improve the quality of life for those with the disease; and

Whereas, cystic fibrosis is a life-threatening genetic disease that attacks the lungs and digestive system; and

Whereas, just fifty years ago, children with cystic fibrosis rarely lived long enough to attend elementary school and today, people with cystic fibrosis are living into their thirties, forties and beyond; and

Whereas, the Tulsa's New Leaders April 2nd event, benefiting the Sooner-Tulsa Chapter of the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation, will honor some of Tulsa's most outstanding men and women who have demonstrated great leadership, been active as volunteers, or excelled in Metro Tulsa's business community;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, do hereby proclaim April 2, 2015, as

"Tulsa's New Leaders Day"

in the state of Oklahoma.
